Founded in the 1950's by a group of banks, businesses, community organizations and individuals, HEAF annually awards sixteen \$1,000 scholarships to the best and the brightest students in a business-related field from select Maine colleges.

HEAF scholars are selected by their colleges primarily on the basis of academic standing. The other criteria for the scholarship are upper class enrollment in a business-related program, graduation from a Maine high school, and eligibility for financial aid.
