*Founded in the 1950's by a group of banks, businesses, community organizations and individuals, HEAF annually awards sixteen \$1,000 scholarships to the best and the brightest students in a business-related field from select Maine colleges.*

*HEAF scholars are selected by their colleges primarily on the basis of academic standing. The other criteria for the scholarship are upper class enrollment in a business-related program, graduation from a Maine high school, and eligibility for financial aid.*

*The scholarship is funded by a \$5,000 donation from the Independent Community Bankers Association of Maine, earmarked for the five campuses of the Maine Community College System, as well as \$20 from each registration fee paid at the Maine Bankers Association's annual directors' conferences.*
